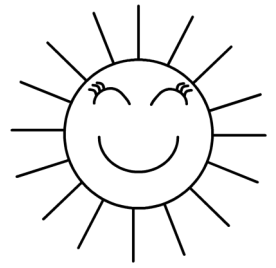

**Patios**

**Parking/Vehicles**

Absolutely **NO PARKING** in Fire lanes, Authorized Reserved spaces, or Handicap spaces without proper tag/plates. Violators are subject to having their vehicle towed, and all costs related to retrieving the vehicle will be at the owner's expense. Please be sure your vehicle inspection stickers are current, and vehicles are operable to prevent you being in violation of paragraph 21 of your lease.
