Are you a City of San Antonio resident facing financial hardship during or due to the pandemic and in need of temporary rental assistance?

The Housing Assistance Program may help eligible renters experiencing loss of income during or due to COVID-19 pandemic. Online applications accepted from May 15 - June 5, 2023.

To qualify, applicants must:

- meet income requirements
- provide proof of financial hardship
- be the primary lease holder
- not have received previous rental or relocation assistance program from the city in the last 12 months
